- □ Minimum number of days and volume of milk to be supplied
- Flush to Lean ratio
- Loss of voting rights on non fulfillment
- Discontinuation of membership for continuous default

Active Membership

- New Membership during fixed interval
- Discouraging Non-member pouring
 - □ No patronage benefits before registration
 - Deemed membership beyond stipulated period
- Termination of membership for non participation in AGM

Member Economic Participation

- Matching Equity contributions to Milk Pouring
- Appreciation of Share Capital
- Appropriation of Share Capital to member entities
- Transfer of shares within members
- Refund of shares at book value
- Patronage based voting for federation

Specific Governance Features

- □ Disclosure norms for Board Members
- Qualification of Managing Director
- □ Annual Performance Report of Board members
- □ Distinction- Responsibility of Board and MD
- □ Co-option of expert members
- □ Fiduciary responsibility and avoiding personal bias
