Plants used as Raasnaa in Indian medicine: Alpinia galangaWilld. (Zingiberaceae) in southern India; Pluchea lanceolat Clarke (Compositae; Asteraceae) in Uttar Pradesh; Vanda roxburghii R. Br. (Orchidaceae) in eastern Uttar Pradesh and W Bengal; Blepharispermum subsessile DC. (Compositae; Asteraceae) in Madhya Pradesh; and Dodonaea viscosa (Linn.). (Sapindaceae) in AndhraPradesh.

Morphology:

Perennial shrub, aromatic one, resembles to ginger leaves, aromatic.

Leaves - smaller than A.galanga oblong ,glabrous,acuminate. Edge is Sharpe

Flower - fragrant, greenish white, dense pedicles.

Fruits - capsule- orange red

Mode of propagation by rhizome.
